Telephone and Telegraph entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the Board of Directors of the CKC may otherwise authorize. NOTE: Please mail at least 15 days prior to closing date to ensure that your entries will arrive on time.

All fees are payable in Canadian Funds. In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. **Fax entries** and/or **credit card payment** will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. \$1.00 per dog per show will be added for FAX/Credit Card entries. Customers who charges are declined by the BankCard Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$25.00 for each transaction declined. **FAX NUMBER** (780)539-6918.

Telephone entries will not be accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received with fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date.

Exhibitors Please Note: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Agility Rules and Regulations are available for \$5.00 plus GST from the CKC

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that his has occurred.

CLASSIFICATION

Novice A: For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or organization

Novice B: For agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Intermediate: Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs who have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent Title.

Excellent A: Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Excellent B: Open to all dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent Title

Veterans Class: At the option of the handler, a dog years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog must retain titles and/or Qualifying scores toward titles accumulated.

Standard & Standard Jumpers with weaves height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. The judge may require any dog to be measured. The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Standard & St. Jumpers with Weaves Classes:

8 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12 inches - for dogs 10 to 14 inches at the withers
16 inches - for dogs 14 to 18 inches at the withers
20 inches - for dogs 18 to 22 inches at the withers
24 inches - for dogs 22 inches and over at the withers

Selected Classes: Follow the rules for Agility Trials and the courses will be the same as the regular classes but will have adjusted height and course times. The Novice Select Class is not divided into A and B Divisions. Dogs can only be entered in Selected Class or in Regular Classes at the same set of trials, however, they may move back and forth between the two at different sets of trials.

Selected Jumpers With Weaves – as above, with no division of the Novice class

Selected Standard & Selected Jumpers with Weaves Height Divisions:
Rules as above

4 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
8 inches - for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
12 inches - for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
16 inches - for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
20 inches - for dogs 22 inches and over at the withers
