

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors patrons, or equipment.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under C.K.C. rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. The ring shall not be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied with a fee set by CKC which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog **BEFORE** taking it to the Judging ring.
10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from completion by action of the Show Committee.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12 - 18 MONTH-12 months & under 18 months on the day of the show

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

CANADIAN BRED – Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

VETERANS - open to all dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veterans Male & Female classes will not compete for Championship points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Veteran dogs may be neutered or spayed.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. Should a dog entered for Specials Only place in its group at the show then all awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female: Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

STUD DOG & GET - The name of the Stud Dog must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the dog and two of his progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY - The name of the Bitch must be indicated on the entry form, the name of the get must also be on the entry form. The entry will consist of the bitch and two of her progeny. Entry in this class need not be the property of the same owner although ALL must be entered in regular classes or Specials Only or Exhibition Only

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

All dogs entered in these non-regular classes must be entered in one of the Regular CKC Classes of Specials Only or Exhibition Only

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder. **_NEW:** A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

OBEDIENCE – TRIAL SUNDAY

PERPETUAL TROPHIES

The Donna Rioux Memorial Trophy, offered by Donna's friends through the Bouvier des Flandres Club of Canada for the Highest Scoring Bouvier in Obedience at the BdFCC National Specialty. The winner of each Highest Scoring Bouvier in Obedience at the BdFCC National Specialty at which this trophy is offered shall have his name and date engraved on the wooden base at the donors expense.

CLASSIFICATION - OBEDIENCE

NOVICE “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

NOVICE “C” - Dogs entered in this class may be of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or other advanced Obedience title in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors in this class may enter more than one dog but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit & Down exercised when they are judged in the same group.

OPEN “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled. The dog must have earned it C.D. Title to enter this class.

OPEN “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada. The dog must have earned it C.D. title to enter this class.

UTILITY - This class shall be for purebred dogs of any breed, which have won the title of C.D.X in Canada. Handlers, trainers & kennel employees may compete in this class.

PRE-NOVICE - shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

VETERANS - the veterans' class is performed under the rules described for the novice class. Dogs must be 7 years of age or older PRIOR to the closing of entries. Dogs must also have a minimum CD title

BRACE - The Brace Class is open to any 2 dogs of either sex that has attained not less than a CD title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person own both dogs.

SWEEPSTAKES

Judge - Sherryanne Farr

Juvenile:

Classes (Sexes divided) 6 - 9 months, 9 -12 months, 12-18 months.
All dogs between the ages of 6 and 18 months on the day of the Specialty shall be eligible to compete regardless of place of birth.

All dog entered in the sweepstakes must be also entered in a regular class at this Specialty

Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best in Sweep 25% of entry fees
Best of Opposite in Sweeps 20% of entry fees
First in each class 5% of entry fees
2nd to 4th in each class..... Rosette

The 25% of all Sweepstakes money received is retained for administration purposes in each sweepstakes.

Veterans:

Classes (Sexes divided) 7-9 years, 10+ years

All dogs entered in the sweepstakes must be also entered in a regular class at this Specialty.
