

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors patrons, or equipment.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under C.K.C. rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. The ring shall not be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied with a fee set by CKC which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring.
10. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
11. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from completion by action of the Show Committee.

JUDGING ASSIGNMENT

All Specialty Classes in Obedience – William Blair

CLASSIFICATION - OBEDIENCE

NOVICE “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

OPEN “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled. The dog must have earned it C.D. Title to enter this class.

OPEN “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada. The dog must have earned it C.D. title to enter this class.

UTILITY - This class shall be for purebred dogs of any breed, which have won the title of C.D.X in Canada. Handlers, trainers & kennel employees may compete in this class.

PRE-NOVICE – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BRACE - The Brace Class is open to any 2 Newfoundland dogs of either sex that have attained not less than a CD title in Canada. It is not necessary that the same person owns both dogs. The Brace Class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the 2 dogs as though they were one. Exhibitors may enter more than one brace in this class, but must have a separate handler for each brace in the Long Sit and Long Down Exercises when judged in the same group.

VETERANS - The Veterans Class shall be for dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
